

Chain of Custody Policy

Reliance Forest Fibre Pty Ltd as trustee for the Reliance Forest Fibre Trust (RFF) is committed to pursuing responsible industry practices in environmental performance and to comply with FSC® Standard 40-004 and FSC Standard 40-005 and Responsible Wood standard AS 4707:2021. Commitment to this policy will see the company and its suppliers:

- 1. Comply with environmental legislation, regulations, standards (including those mentioned above) and codes of practice relevant to our business.
- 2. Actively consult and engage with estate holders, suppliers and other stakeholders to ensure civil and legal rights are observed.
- 3. Provide assurance of connection, integrity and validity of the wood and forest products certified by Chain of Custody.
- 4. Source and segregate wood fibre that excludes wood harvested which is:
 - a) Illegally harvested wood
 - b) Wood harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights
 - c) Wood harvested in forests where high conservation values are threatened by management activities
 - d) Wood harvested in forests being converted to plantations or non- forest use
 - e) Wood from forests in which genetically modified tress are planted
 - f) Wood harvested in violation of international treaties
- 5. Actively monitor and verify all sources of wood fibre delivered to RFF according to the standard
- 6. Only conduct our business with companies who have a commitment to responsible environmental policies and an understanding of Controlled Wood and Chain of Custody standards. Companies will adhere to all requirements of the standards and all relevant state and federal legislation including taxation.
- 7. Communicate and consult openly about our activities and report progress on our environmental performance.
- 8. Demonstrate a clear commitment and alignment through our managers, employees and operating procedures.

The Management of RFF are committed to ensuring compliance by all people who work for or supply the company with its needs and will allocate resources to meet this commitment.
