- Independent certification of our forest practices.
- Undertake Company activities in a socially responsible manner providing a safe working environment for staff, contractors and visitors while respecting the social and cultural values of stakeholders and the local community
- Proactively engage and value the contributions of our stakeholders
- · Conduct business in an honest manner and not tolerate any form of corruption or bribery
- Comply with relevant legislation, regulation, Government policies, codes of practice and other external
 requirements relating to our business, this includes laws and treaties related to anti-corruption and
 anti-bribery.
- Conservation management of natural and cultural values delivered through strategic review, preplanning and operational implementation
- Not to degrade or convert native ecosystems
- Not to use genetically modified trees in any of our operations
- Set and review objectives and targets to mitigate any significant impacts
- Monitor operations to continually improve forest management and environmental outcomes
- Regularly monitor, audit and review our system and performance to facilitate continual improvement
- Ensure our staff and contractors have sufficient information, skills, training and resources to implement this policy,
- Communicate this policy with staff, business partners, service providers and customers.
